The main goal of the Follow-Up survey is to obtain complete and precise responses from the students who achieved the concentrator status and left school from a Career and Technical Education program in the 2022-2023 school year. CEPD Administrators are to use CTEIS to authorize the release of their districts' Follow-Up data to OCTE no later than January 18, 2024.
