Final Enrollment Deadline

Remember, May 16th is the last day that students may be entered into CTEIS. To generate funding, these students must:

- 1) be enrolled in at least one CTE course in CTEIS.
- 2) have a valid UIC attached to their profile.

Did You Know?

Due to last year's funding formula change, the cap on the number of students an instructor can teach has been removed. In CTEIS, this means that you may continue combining subsections in your courses or you may import each subsection as its own standalone course. Remember to verify all of your course details and segments!
